







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Intervention Points for Solving the Personhood Jigsaw Puzzle- Relational Personhood Ring Theory of Personhood (Krishna, 2015)

A systematic and holistic approach




Strategies

- Ordinary social relationships that can disappear when someone is dying, and the medical system moves in daily tasks, activities and social networks become overlooked
- To reinsert ordinary into the extraordinary, the following strategies have been tested...
 - Individuals championing for change in the society
 - Health promotion for awareness raising
 - Community development for working with schools, community groups and enhancing existing networks
 - Formal volunteering schemes giving practical support and help
 - Community engagement for dialogues and shaping of EoL care services
