



Hospital Authority (HA) obstetric units

Information to Expectant Mothers

- You are advised to have antenatal care that is essential for the health and safety of you and your baby.
- You should be aware that your antenatal record provides important medical information and is essential for optimal obstetric care.
- You are advised to go to the hospital where you have booked for obstetric service as early as you can when you go into labour, so that timely care and treatment would be provided. Standard of care could be compromised if your antenatal record is not accessible.
- To avoid untoward delay in getting proper care, you are advised NOT to go to hospitals that do not have obstetric service in case of labour or obstetric emergency.
